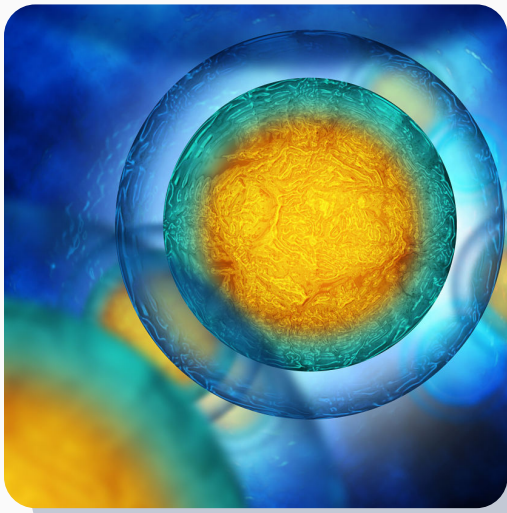


THE SENIOR CAPSTONE PROCESS



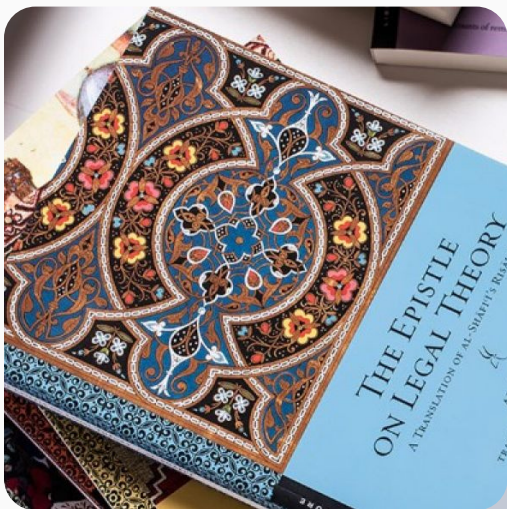
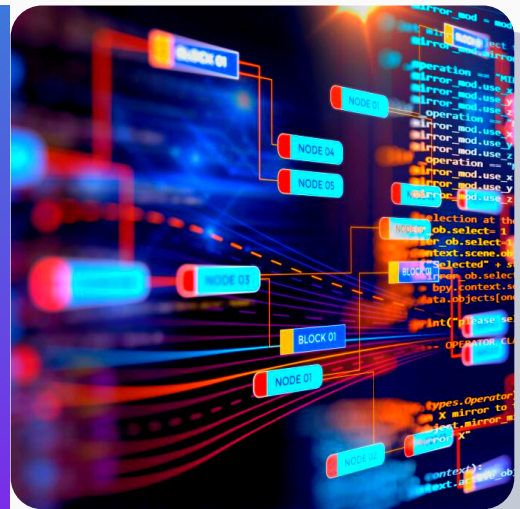
ENROLL IN HON 301

1

Spring of the junior year. Students will enroll in HON 301, the Honors Research Methods Seminar. Class sections are determined by discipline. By the end of the class, you should have an idea of your topic and the current state of research on it

2 SELECT YOUR SENIOR CAPSTONE

This takes place March of the Junior year. Students may take choose from HON 401, the research-based capstone, or HON 484/485, the project-based capstone.



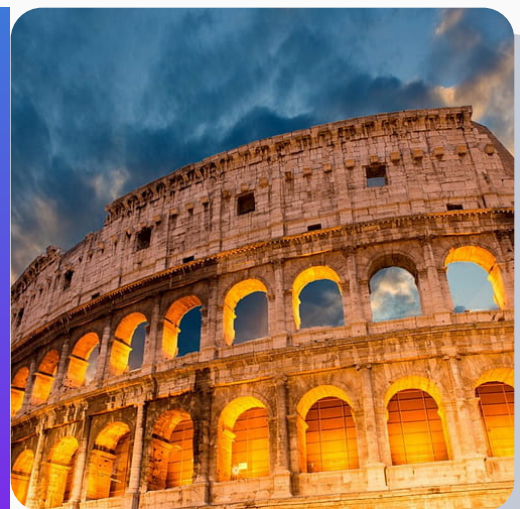
ENROLL IN THE SENIOR CAPSTONE

Fall of the senior year- All Students enroll in the major capstone. Project based capstone students take HON 484 in the fall and HON 485 in spring. HON 401 students attend tutorial sessions in fall, and HON 401 in spring of the senior year.
